Please read and take special note of entry and fee payment requirements

GENERAL

- 1. It is expected that players will have read and agree with the 'Conditions of Entry' prior submitting an entry.
- 2. Any player entering must be a member of, and in good standing with an association affiliated to Badminton New Zealand or the Badminton World Federation.
- 3. The rules of play shall be those of the Badminton World Federation.
- 4. The BWF scoring system is to be used.
- 5. Service rule. This event will be played using the Alternative Service Law 9.1.6. a) the whole shuttle shall be below the server's waist at the instant of being hit by the server's racket. The waist shall be considered to be an imaginary line round the body, level with the lowest part of the server's bottom rib; b) the shaft and the racket head of the server's racket at the instant of hitting the shuttle shall be pointing in a downward direction.
- 6. All questions as to the rules shall be resolved by an appointed tournament official.
- 7. Yonex feather shuttles will be used.
- 8. A Plate (first match loser) will be held in all events, if numbers are sufficient. Plate entry is automatic for the losers of their first match. A Classic Plate (second match loser) and Consolation Plate (first match plate loser) will be held in singles only as long as time and entries permit. The final decision will be made by the Tournament Organising Committee and the Referee. Players wishing to withdraw must advise the Tournament Controller immediately after their first match loss. If a player defaults, withdraws or retires (does not compete) their first match, they are not eligible for the plate.
- 9. The tournament will be seeded using the most recent Badminton NZ Player Ranking listing available at the time of the draw.
- 10. The draw will be made on Friday 25th September 2020 and will be available on the Badminton New Zealand and Badminton Canterbury websites. The first days schedule will be available from Sunday 27th September 2020.
- 11. The tournament director and/or Referee reserve the right to cancel any event in which fewer than 4 entries are received, or it time does not permit a full competition to be played. The tournament director and/or Referee reserve the right to default any player who is not available to play at the scheduled time.

PLAYER REQUIREMENTS

12. Players must obtain permission to leave the hall.

- 13. Players will be defaulted if they are not on court ready to play within two minutes of being called.
- 14. Players must wear regulation badminton clothing as per the Badminton New Zealand Approved Clothing regulations. Non-marking shoes must be worn.
- 15. All players must act as umpires or line judges when requested. Failure to do so may result in the player being defaulted.
- 16. Players compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during the tournament.
- 17. Following one warning of misconduct, the Referee shall have the authority to disqualify a player from further play if there is a repeat of misconduct.
- 18. Under 17 players must be born 2004 or later, Under 15 players 2006 or later, Under 13 players 2008 or later.
- 19. Players may enter either the U13, U15 or U17 age group events, but can only enter one age group.

ENTRY DETAILS

- 20. Entry can only be made online and must be received no later than 23:59 on Friday 18th September 2020. Online entry can be made through www.badmintoncanterbury.com and www.badminton.org.nz.
- 21. Entries for doubles and mixed doubles will not be accepted unless full payment is received from both partners by the closing time/date. This excludes 'partner required' entries. It is not the responsibility of Badminton Canterbury to follow up entries from nominated, un-entered partners.
- 22. Players withdrawing after entries have closed will not be eligible for a refund unless a medical certificate is submitted at the time of withdrawal.
- 23. Players may withdraw from individual events without being required to withdraw from all events.
- 24. There will be no replacements in the singles events.
- 25. Replacements in doubles and mixed doubles events after the draw is published may be allowed only with the approval of the tournament director or referee in line with the BWF competition regulations. Replacement players can only be sought from players already entered in the tournament.
- 26. A \$10 administration fee will be deducted from all refunds.
- 27. A BNZ player levy of \$12.00 is compulsory for each player.
