CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

General

1. It is expected that players will have read and are familiar with the 'Conditions of Entry and Play' prior to submitting an entry.
2. Players entering must be a member of, and in good standing, with an Association affiliated to Badminton New Zealand or the Badminton World Federation.
3. The rules of play shall be those of the Badminton World Federation.
4. The BWF scoring system will be used.
5. All players will be entitled to a minimum of 15 minutes break between main draw matches.
6. This event will be played using the Alternative Service Law 9.1.6. a) the whole shuttle shall be below the server's waist at the instant of being hit by the server's racket. The waist shall



be considered to be an imaginary line round the body, level with the lowest part of the server's bottom rib; b) the shaft and the racket head of the server's racket at the instant of hitting the shuttle shall be pointing in a downward direction.

7. All questions as to rules shall be resolved by the appointed Tournament Official.
8. VICTOR shuttles will be used.
9. The tournament will be seeded using the most recent national rankings available (in the U13 Age category) as at the closing date 7th October 2021
10. The draw and schedule will be published by 11.59pm **Wednesday 13th October 2021**, on the Badminton New Zealand and Waikato Badminton websites.
11. The Tournament Committee and/or Referee reserve the right to:
 - Cancel any event due to Covid-19 related restrictions, insufficient entries, or if time does not permit a full competition to be played.
 - Change the scoring of plate events if time constraints require.
 - Default a player who is not available to play at the scheduled time.

Player Requirements

12. Players entering the Under 13 age group in 2021 will be born in 2009 or later, i.e. **under 13 at 31/12/2021**
13. Competitors must obtain permission to leave the hall.
14. Players will be defaulted if they are not on court ready to play within 5 minutes of being called. Note: Players may be called upon up to 10 minutes ahead of the scheduled time.
15. Players must wear regulation badminton clothing as per the BNZ Approved Clothing regulations.
16. All players must act as umpires or line judges when requested. Failure to do so may result in the player being defaulted.
17. Players compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during the tournament.
18. Following one warning for misconduct, the appointed Tournament Official shall have the authority to disqualify a player from further play if there is a repeat of misconduct.

Entry Details

19. Entry can only be made online and must be received no later than 11.59pm on **Thursday 7th October**. Online entry is available via: www.badminton.org.nz and www.waikatobadminton.co.nz
20. Entries for Doubles and Mixed Doubles will not be accepted unless entries, with full payment, are received from both partners by the closing time/date. This excludes 'Partner required' entries. It is not the responsibility of Waikato Badminton to follow up entries from nominated, but un-entered partners.
21. Players withdrawing after entries have closed will not be eligible for a refund unless a medical certificate is submitted at the time of withdrawal. Players may withdraw from individual events without being required to withdraw from all events
22. There will be no replacements in Singles events.
23. Replacements in Doubles and Mixed doubles events after the draw is published may be allowed only with the approval of the Tournament Official or Referee. Replacement players can only be sought from players already entered in the tournament - in line with BWF competition regulations.



24. There shall be at least ONE Plate event for each discipline.
25. Plate entry is automatic for the losers of their first match. Players wishing to withdraw must advise the Tournament Official immediately after their first match loss. If a player defaults, withdraws or retires (does not complete) their first match, they are not eligible for the plate.
- 26. A \$10 administration fee will be deducted from all refunds.**
27. A compulsory BNZ player levy of \$12 is payable by all players.

Entry Fees

28. Entry fees are as follows:
 - One Event: \$37 (Including BNZ player levy)
 - Two Events: \$57
 - Three Events: \$72

Entry fees are to be paid via Paypal as part of your online entry. Entries will not be accepted into the draws until payment is made and received.
