INTER-ASSOCIATION COMMITTEE

TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Inter-Association Committee is an advisory committee to the Badminton New Zealand staff who are responsible for the day-to-day management and oversight of the Badminton New Zealand Inter-Association competition.

The objective of this committee is to contribute to the future direction of Inter-Association at all levels and assist to ensure that the competitions are future-focused, innovative, and relevant.

KEY ROLES

- Provide advice to Badminton New Zealand on the future direction of Seniors, Masters, Veterans and Super-Veterans Inter-Association.
- Where relevant, collect feedback from all Badminton New Zealand Associations on key proposals.
- Annual revision of the Badminton New Zealand Inter-Association Bylaws.

MEETINGS

Most communications for this committee will be via email, Zoom or similar.

COMMITTEE MEMBERS

- The Inter-Association Committee will comprise of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 members.
- A maximum of one representative from each Association.
- The Events Manager is an ex-officio member.

- Badminton New Zealand Board Members may be a member of this committee should they be nominated.
- Terms are for two years, with the term commencing 1st of January, the year following nomination. An exception is the first term of the committee which will conclude on 31st December, 2022.
- Nominated persons must have a good understanding of Inter-Association.
- The Badminton New Zealand Events Manager to make recommendations for the committee to the Chief Executive following the receipt of nominations. The Chief Executive will confirm committee members within 14 days of nominations closing.
- Following this the Badminton New Zealand Events Manager will advise Association's of the outcome of their nomination and contact the individual to confirm their appointment prior to public announcement.
- One of the selected candidates will be nominated to the position of Chair of the Committee.
