RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. It is expected that players will have read, and agreed with the 'Conditions of Entry' prior to submitting an entry.
- 2. Any player entering must be a member of, and in good standing with an association affiliated to Badminton New Zealand or the Badminton World Federation.
- 3. The rules of play shall be those of the Badminton World Federation.
- 4. The BWF scoring system is to be used.
- 5. All questions as to the rules shall be resolved by an appointed tournament official
- 6. RSL Tourney brand shuttles will be used.
- 7. The tournament director and/or Referee reserve the right to:
 - Cancel any event in which fewer than 4 entries are received, or if time does not permit a full competition to be played.
 - Change the scoring if time constraints require.

Default a player who is not available to play at the scheduled time.

SEEDINGS AND DRAW

- 1. The tournament will be seeded using the most recent National ranking list in the u19 category available at the time of the draw
- 2. The draw will be made available on the Badminton New Zealand and Auckland Badminton websites. The first day's schedule will be available from Wednesday 7th Sep
- 3. There will be one plate event in each event at this tournament if numbers are sufficient. Plate entry is automatic for the losers of their first match. Players wishing to withdraw must advise the tournament controller immediately after their first match loss. If a player defaults, withdraws, or retires (does not compete) their first match, they are not eligible for the plate

ENTRY DETAILS

- Entry can only be made online and must be received no later than 23:59 on Friday 02nd Sep 2022.
 Online entry can be made through <u>www.aklbadminton.com</u> and <u>www.badminton.org.nz</u>
- 5. Entries for doubles and mixed doubles will not be accepted unless full payment is received from both partners by the closing time/date. This excludes 'partner required' entries. It is not the responsibility of Auckland Badminton to follow up entries from nominated, un-entered partners.
- 6. Players withdrawing after entries have closed will not be eligible for a refund unless a medical certificate is submitted at the time of withdrawal.
- 7. "A refund less a \$15 administration fee will be provided for players who have a) paid in full, b) advised via their entry that a partner is required and c) where a partner is not available".
- 8. There will be no refunds for players withdrawing after the tournament has commenced.
- 9. There will be no replacements in the singles events.
- 10. Replacements in doubles and mixed doubles events after the draw is published may be allowed only with the approval of the tournament director or referee – in line with the BWF competition regulations. Replacement players can only be sought from players already entered in the tournament.
- 11. Players may withdraw from individual events, without being required to withdraw from all events
- 12. A compulsory BNZ player levy of \$12.00 is payable by all players.

ENTRY FEES

- 1. Allow at least two working days for payments to be processed through the banking system.
- The entry fee must be in the Auckland Badminton Association's bank account no later than Wednesday 7th Sep 2022 or the player will be withdrawn from the event, even if the on-line entry was received ontime.

ONE EVENT :	\$45.00 per player incl. BNZ Player Levy \$ 12
TWO EVENTS :	\$70.00 per player (\$45 + \$25, One + Two events)
THREE EVENTS:	\$95.00 per player (\$45 + \$25 + \$25, One + Two + Three events)

EVENTS explained:

One event- You play Singles or Doubles or Mixed Doubles

Two events- You play (Singles & Doubles) or (Singles & Mixed Doubles) or (Doubles & Mixed Doubles) Three events- You play all Singles, Doubles & Mixed Doubles.

PLAYER REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Player must obtain permission to leave the hall
- 2. Player will be defaulted if they are not on court ready to play within two minutes of being called. Note: Players may be called upon up to 10 minutes ahead of the scheduled time.
- 3. Players must wear regulation badminton clothing as per the Badminton New Zealand approved clothing regulations.
- 4. All players must act as umpires, or line judges when requested. Failure to do so may result in the player being defaulted. Please check the website prior to the session for player umpires (if needed)
- 5. Players compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during this tournament.
- 6. Following one warning of misconduct, the referee shall have the authority to disqualify a player from further play if there is a repeat of misconduct.
- 7. Players must be under 19 as at 31 December 2022 to participate, i.e. must be born no earlier than 2004.

COVID-19

- Auckland Badminton will follow the COVID-19 requirements as advised by the New Zealand Government, Ministry of Health and Sport New Zealand throughout this tournament. Such requirements may include, but are not limited to: contact tracing, physical distancing, face coverings and personal hygiene.
- 2. Auckland Badminton reserves the rights to suspend, postpone or cancel the tournament in line with these requirements.
- 3. Auckland Badminton will allow players to withdraw from the tournament at any point up until their first match of the tournament due to concerns regarding COVID-19 by notifying Auckland

Badminton or the referee of their withdrawal. A player utilizing this clause to withdraw will receive a full refund and will be withdrawn from all events.

- 4. If a player returns a positive test result for COVID-19 after the close of entries, this player shall be withdrawn from the tournament unless subsequently cleared by a medical professional. The player shall be entitled to a full refund of entry fees, and their partners shall receive a refund for the affected events if a suitable substitute is not available.
- 5. Auckland Badminton will provide players with a full refund of their entry fee if the tournament is suspended, postponed or cancelled, however will not consider financial reimbursement of any other costs related to the tournament.
- 6. Auckland Badminton reserves the rights to disqualify any player from the tournament who are deemed to have disregarded any reasonable instruction related to the Auckland Badminton COVID-19 response.
