CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Take note:

All attendees and supporters will be required to have their vaccine passports scanned on entering the venue.

Please read and take special note of entry and fee payment requirements.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. It is expected that players will have read and are familiar with the 'Conditions of Entry' prior to submitting an entry.
- 2. Any player entering must be a member of, and in good standing with an association affiliated to Badminton New Zealand or the Badminton World Federation.
- 3. The rules of play shall be those of the Badminton World Federation.
- 4. The BWF scoring system is to be used.
- 5. This event will be played using the Alternative Service Law 9.1.6
 - a) the whole shuttle shall be below the server's waist at the instant of being hit by the server's racket. The waist shall be considered to be an imaginary line round the body, level with the lowest part of the server's bottom rib;
 - b) the shaft and the racket head of the server's racket at the instant of hitting the shuttle shall be pointing in a downward direction'.
- 6. All questions as to the rules shall be resolved by an appointed tournament official.
- 7. Yonex AS30 shuttles will be used.
- 8. The tournament organisers and/or Referee reserve the right to:
 - 1. Cancel any event in which fewer than 8 entries are received, or if time does not permit full competition to be played.
 - 2. Default a player who is not available to play at the scheduled time.

SEEDINGS AND DRAW

- 1. The seedings will be awarded by a panel appointed by Bay of Plenty Badminton.
- 2. The draw and schedule will be published on Wednesday, 30 March 2022, and will be available on https://badminton.org.nz/event/bay-of-plenty-masters-open-2022/website.

ENTRY DETAILS

 Entries can only be made online and must be received no later than 23:59 on, Friday 25th March 2022. Online entry is available under the Events section on the Badminton New Zealand website - https://badminton.org.nz/event/bay-of-plenty-masters-open-2022/

2. Grading

2.1. Open Grade

- 2.1.1. If you played in the New Zealand Senior Division 1-3 or South Island Division 1 Inter Association in 2019, 2020 or 2021.
- 2.1.2. If you played in the New Zealand Masters Division 1-2, North Island Masters 1-2, South Island Masters Division 1, Veterans Division 1, or Super-Vets Division 1 in 2019, 2020 or 2021.
- 2.1.3. If you have won a New Zealand Championship title in the last 10 years, including Master's titles.

2.2. Division 2

- 2.2.1. If none of the above in rule 2.1 apply.
- 2.3. The Referee and/or Event Director may re-grade any player at their discretion, with the aim of ensuring a fair competition for all participants.

3. Open Grade Events

- 1. Men's Singles, Women's Singles, Men's Doubles, Women's Doubles and Mixed Doubles
- 2. Age Groups: 35+, 50+ and 60+.
- 3. In Singles, players may only enter 1 age group.
- 4. In Doubles and Mixed Doubles, players may only enter 2 age groups.

4. Division 2 Events

- 1. Men's Singles, Women's Singles, Men's Doubles, Women's Doubles and Mixed Doubles
- 2. Age Groups: 35+, 50+, 60+. Age groups may be combined depending on the number of entries received.
- 3. In singles, players may only enter 1 age group.
- 4. In Doubles and Mixed Doubles, players may only enter 2 age groups.
- 5. Both players in the pair need to meet the criteria of division 2.

- 5. Players may enter open events & retain their eligibility for division 2.
- 6. Players may not enter a combination of Open Grade and Division Two events within the same discipline (i.e. a player cannot enter mixed doubles in Division Two and in the Open Grade)
- 7. Entries for doubles and mixed doubles will not be accepted unless full payment is received from both partners by the closing time/date. This excludes 'partner required' entries. It is not the responsibility of the tournament organiser to follow up entries from nominated un- entered partners.
- 8. Players must be Over 35 Born in 1987 or earlier, Over 50 Born in 1972 and Over 60 Born in 1962 or earlier.
- 9. A player may withdraw from individual events without being required to withdraw from all events.
- 10. Players withdrawing after entries have closed will not be eligible for a refund unless a medical certificate is submitted at the time of withdrawal.
- 11. There will be no refunds for players withdrawing after the tournament has commenced. Players can withdraw from individual events without being required to withdraw from all events.
- 12. There will be no replacements in the singles events.
- 13. Replacements in doubles and mixed doubles events after the draw is published may be allowed only with the approval of the tournament organiser or referee. Replacement players can only be sought from players already entered in the tournament.
- 14. A \$10 administration fee will be deducted from all refunds.
- 15. A Compulsory BNZ player levy of \$12.00 is payable by all players (included in first, second and third event).

ENTRY FEES

- NB Bank account number does not identify the player if your system does not allow entry of alpha characters then use your BNZ player number. Do not use your date of birth. When entering on-line indicate your payment date.
- 1. Allow at least two working days for payments to be processed through the banking system.
- 2. The entry fee must be in the Bay of Plenty Badminton Association's bank account no later than Thursday 25th March 2022 or the player will be withdrawn from the event, even if the entry was received on-time.

PLAYER REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Players must ensure that the tournament organiser is advised if they wish to leave the hall.
- 2. Players will be defaulted if they are not on court ready to play within two minutes of being called.
- 3. Players must wear regulation badminton clothing as per the Badminton New Zealand Approved Clothing regulations.
- 4. All players must act as umpires or line judges when requested. Failure to do so may result in the player being defaulted. Please check the websites prior to the session for player umpires (if needed).
- 5. Players compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during this tournament.

COVID-19

- 1. Bay of Plenty Badminton will follow the COVID-19 requirements as advised by the New Zealand Government, Ministry of Health and Sport New Zealand throughout these Events. Such requirements may include, but are not limited to: contact tracing, physical distancing, face coverings and personal hygiene.
- 2. Bay of Plenty Badminton reserves the rights to suspend, postpone or cancel the Bay of Plenty Masters Open in line with these requirements.
- 3. If a player returns a positive test result for COVID-19 after the close of entries, this player shall be withdrawn from the tournament unless subsequently cleared by a medical professional. The player shall be entitled to a full refund of entry fees, and their partners shall receive a refund for the affected events if a suitable substitute is not available.
- 4. If a player returns a positive test result for COVID-19 after the close of entries, this player shall be withdrawn from the tournament unless subsequently cleared by a medical professional. The player shall be entitled to a full refund of entry fees, and their partners shall receive a refund for the affected events if a suitable substitute is not available.
- 5. Bay of Plenty Badminton will provide players with a full refund of their entry fee if the Bay of Plenty Masters Open is suspended, postponed, or cancelled, however will not consider financial reimbursement of any other costs related to the Open.
- 6. Bay of Plenty Badminton reserves the rights to disqualify any player from the Bay of Plenty Masters Open who are deemed to have disregarded any reasonable instruction related to the Bay of Plenty Badminton COVID-19 response.

- 7. Everyone needs to scan the contact tracing QR code or fill in your details on our contact tracing sheet as you enter the venue.
- 8. Everyone over the age of 12 years and 3 months entering the venue must have and a valid "My Vaccine Pass". We are required to scan your "My Vaccine Pass" prior to you entering the venue.
- 9. Other conditions of entry into the venue, include
 - You do not have any symptoms associated with COVID-19 (e.g. fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, sneezing/runny nose or loss of sense of smell)
 - You do not have COVID-19 nor are you awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test.
 - You have not been in contact with any known or suspected cases of COVID-19 in the past 14 days
 - You have not returned, or been in contact with anyone else who has returned, from overseas in the past 14 days
 - Face masks are encouraged when you are not playing, eating, or drinking
