Player Development Coach - Requirements and Duties

- Three years or more of recent badminton coaching experience.
- Provincial or national competitive badminton level playing experience preferable.
- Strong desire and dedication to the development of young athletes.
- Minimum of BWF Level one coaching certification or equivalent.
- Ability to work well within a team environment.
- Excellent interpersonal, analytical, evaluation and planning skills.
- Responsible for the development and creation of School of Badminton programs with support from the Academy Coordinator and other School of Badminton coaches as required.
- Support and promote Junior/Senior integration for depth in standards.
- Create and maintain a positive learning environment for coaches and players to improve their skills and abilities.
- Ability to lead group and individual badminton lessons, develop and implement new training strategies, tactics, and schedules.
- Travel required both locally and nationally with players.
- Motivate and encourage players at training and/or competition. This includes being an active and inspiring role model for the sport of badminton.
- Provide feedback to players, family members, coaches, and School management as required.
- To assist in administration & organisational duties of players, sessions & structures.
- Collaboration opportunity with other clubs and organisations to deliver training as required.
- Compliance with any other external vetting scheme.
