Quarterfinals onwards GCR 21 regarding clothing colour will apply:</li> <li>In Singles matches opposing players must wear significantly different coloured clothing</li> <li>In doubles matches both players must wear the same colour clothing and opposing pairs must wear significantly different coloured clothing</li> </ul>
