Conditions of Entry

Take note:

Please read and take a special note of entry fee payment requirements and coaching.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. It is expected that players will have read and are familiar with the 'Conditions of Entry' prior to submitting an entry.
2. Any player entering must be a member of an association affiliated with Badminton New Zealand or the Badminton World Federation. All players must be in good standing with their member association and Badminton New Zealand.
3. All main draw events will be conducted according to current BWF regulations, including scoring.
4. Any alternative scoring or rules may be used in division 2 and 3.
5. This event will be played using the Alternative Service Law 9.1.6. The whole of the shuttle shall be below the server's waist at the instant of being hit by the server's racket. The waist shall be considered to be an imaginary line round the body, level with the lowest part of the server's bottom rib, and; the shaft and racket head of the server's racket at the instant of hitting the shuttle shall be pointing in a downward direction.
6. All questions as to the rules shall be resolved by an appointed tournament official.
7. Tournament grade shuttles will be used.
8. The tournament organizer and/or Referee reserve the right to:
 - a) Cancel any event in which fewer than 8 entries are received, or if time does not permit full competition to be played.
 - b) Default a player who is not available to play at the scheduled time.

COACHING RULES FOR U15 & U19

9. ***Any person coaching during a match, including intervals, must meet the requirements of the Badminton New Zealand Accredited coaches policy. Any person not meeting these criteria who refuses the request of the referee or tournament director to stop coaching may be referred to the Badminton New Zealand disciplinary panel.***

SEEDINGS AND DRAWS

10. Seedings will be completed using the latest Badminton New Zealand National Rankings available at the date of entries closing.
11. The draw and schedule will be published on Monday, 21st April 2025 by 11:59pm, and will be available at:

ETNRY DETAILS

12. Entries for Doubles and Mixed Doubles will not be accepted unless full payment is received from both partners by the closing time/date. This excludes 'partner required' entries. It is not the responsibility of the tournament organiser to follow up entries from nominated un-entered partners.
13. U15 players must be born between 2011 and 2014.
U19 players must be born between 2007 and 2010.
14. Players withdrawing after entries have closed will receive a refund of entry fees, less any administration fees, only on the submission of a medical certificate. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after the tournament has commenced
15. A player may withdraw from individual events without being required to withdraw from all events.
16. There will be no replacements in the singles events.
17. Replacements in doubles and mixed doubles events after the draw is published may be allowed only with the approval of the tournament organiser or referee. Replacement players can only be sought from players already entered in the tournament.
18. Substitution is only allowed in the Doubles events from players who have already entered in the tournament and must be approved by the Referee. Only 1 player in each pair in the draw can be substituted. If 2 players from 2 different pairs in the same event are put together, the placement of the new pair shall be at the position of the pair seeded in the highest seeding group. If none of the pairs are seeded, or seeded in the same seeding group, the position shall be drawn by lot between positions of the 2 original pairs.
19. A compulsory BNZ player levy of \$17.00 is payable by all players (included in the first event).
20. Division 3 will be offered, at the discretion of the tournament organisers, in all events. Participants who do not win their first match in the main draw will go into Division 3. If a player defaults, withdraws, or retires (does not complete game) in their first match, they will not be eligible for Division 3.
21. Entry to Division 3 is automatic for losers of their first match in the main draw. Players wishing to withdraw must advise the tournament controller immediately after their loss.
22. Division 2 will be offered, at the discretion of the tournament organisers, in all events. Participants who win their first match but lose their second match in the main draw will go into Division 2. If a player defaults, withdraws, or retires (does not complete game) in their second match, they will not be eligible for Division 2.
23. Entry to Division 2 is automatic for losers of their second match in the main draw. Players wishing to withdraw must advise the tournament controller immediately after their loss.

24. Division 2 & 3 is not eligible for player points.

PLAYER REQUIREMENTS

25. Players must ensure that the tournament organiser is advised if they wish to leave the hall.
26. Players will be defaulted if they are not on court ready to play within 5 minutes of being called.
27. Players must wear regulation badminton clothing as per the Badminton New Zealand Approved Clothing regulations - <https://badminton.org.nz/wp-content/uploads/2023/10/Clothing-Code-2024.pdf>
28. All players must act as umpires or line judges when requested. Failure to do so may result in the player being defaulted. Please check the websites prior to the session for player umpires (if needed).
29. Players compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during this tournament.

ENTRY FEES

30. The entry fee must be in the Bay of Plenty Badminton Association Bank Account no later than Thursday 15th April 2025 or the player will be withdrawn from the event, even if the entry was received on time.
31. Please allow at least 2 working days for payments to be processed through the banking system.
