

## **ACCREDITED COACHES EXEMPTION**

## **BACKGROUND & PROCESS**

Only BWF Level 2 qualified coaches, and coaches who have coached at a national level are exempt from completing the online coaching module. However, an applicant must complete the following to be issued a 2025 Accredited Coaches Pass to be able to coach at events.

- 1. Evidence of BWF Level 2 Qualification (date the qualification was issued) and/or evidence of national level coaching.
- 2. Applicants will also need to read, sign, and adhere to a Coaches Code of Ethics Form.
- 3. Be Police Vetted a coach must have completed a police vet within the past 2 years.
- 4. Applicants will also need to be verified by an Association to coach on the back of the court.
